Kristina Persson is Deputy Governor of the Sveriges RiskBank. From 1 January 2005 Ms Persson is responsible for strategic issues relating to the Riksbank's information and communication activities. She is a graduate in business administration, has been governor of the county of Jämtland, and has worked at the Ministry of Finance, the Institute for Futures Studies, and as economist at the Swedish Confederation of Professional Employees (TCO). She has also been a Member of Parliament and its Committee on Finance, a member of the Riksbank's General Council and a member of the European Parliament.

Kristina Persson was born in 1945 and is a qualified economist. She has previously worked at the Ministry of Finance (1971-73), the Institute for Futures Studies (1973-76) and at the Swedish Confederation of Professional Employees (1986-93). She was a member of the Riksdag during 1993-95 and was a member of the Riksdag Committee on Finance. During the period 1994-96, she was a member of the General Council of the Riksbank and in 1995 she was a member of the European Parliament.
