Anna Jaguaribe is a Brazilian Sociologist, specialized in political-economic theory and public policy. Prof. Jaguaribe holds graduate degrees from the Ecole Pratique des Hautes Etudes en Science Sociales, Paris, France and PhD, from New York University. She has worked with the United Nations Development Programme, the United Nations Center for Science and Technology as well as UNCTAD and was a Professor at the Institute of Industrial Economics of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro.

She has been a collaborator of the ARELA (European/Latin America Research Association) of the University of Florence, she is associated with the Institute of Political and Social Studies of Rio de Janeiro and at present is the Coordinator of a Network on Globalization and Governance for Globus et Locus in Milan, Italy.
